

Minor in Music (MUSIC)

The minor provides an emphasis in areas designated "applied music", "audio recording techniques", "music history" and "music skills."

The minor in music is a 22 credit hour musical emphasis that may be selected by students who major in a program other than the Bachelor of Arts in Music. The minor, which may be completed in eight or fewer semesters.

Note: Candidates for the Minor must audition. All minors must take Diatonic Harmony before or concurrently with applied lessons.
